

Remembrance Sunday

Following the latest Coronavirus Regulations, we are unable to hold services in the Church for the time being although we will open it for private prayer from 10.00am until 1.30pm each Sunday and Wednesday

An outside Act of Remembrance will be held at 10.50 am this morning although the number attending around the Memorial has to be restricted to the Minister, the server and those actually taking part in the service. It will comprise of prayer, a two-minute silence and wreath laying with a closing prayer and blessing. Others may attend, keeping to the pavement, but a two-metre separation should be observed.

Sadly, at St George's we have been unable to provide on-line amenities whilst in lockdown, however, for those wishing to view church services here are a couple that you might like.

Father Tim says it would be nice to know that some of his former flock were watching his services, go to the Facebook site of **St John the Divine Worthing** where they usually start to live stream at 9.00am on Sundays but this week for Remembrance Sunday they will be starting the live stream at 10.30am to finish at 11.00am with the 2 minutes silence and last post.

Fr Lawson Nagel conducts Mass every Thursday and Sunday mornings whilst churches are closed, go onto Facebook and look for **Lawson Chase Nagel** and ask to become his friend (yes, he will accept you). This will give you access to his Mass Community.

These services are available to watch at a time to suit the viewer.
