### Confirmation For Adults and Older Children

There will be two sets of confirmation classes at St George's, one for adults and one for children who are 13 years old or older. These are open to anyone who wants to be confirmed and, indeed, baptised. For the children's confirmation classes, there is a plan also to have a day out. Do speak to Fr Angus if you are interested.

#### First Communion Classes

First Communion Classes this year will run in June and July. They are open to any child who is baptised and between 7 and 12 years old. Any child who is not baptised is also welcome to join the classes. The children would be admitted to communion and baptised, if necessary, at the All-Age Eucharist on 21 July.
